Proposed Restrictive Covenants

- The Purchaser must not use the property or permit it to be used other than for construction of a private dwelling-house, town houses or apartments for use as single or multi-family residential accommodation (the 'dwelling-house').
- 2. The dwelling-house on the property must not be constructed of materials other than reinforced concrete blocks or coral stone or concrete slabs supported on a steel framework. The roof may be clad with clay tiles wooden or asphalt shingles or with profile sheeting or other similar material but not with corrugated galvanised metal sheets.
- The dwelling-house constructed on the property shall not exceed two stories in height.
- The exterior of the dwelling-house constructed on the property shall be rendered painted or otherwise finished to a high standard within 60 days of practical completion
- 5. The Purchaser must at all times maintain the dwelling-house in good and substantial repair and condition.
- The Purchaser must not construct any fence on the property either with or incorporating corrugated galvanised metal sheets, profile sheeting or other similar material.
- The Purchaser must not at any time carry on or permit to be carried on in or upon the property any trade business or profession whatsoever.
- The Purchaser must not cause or permit or suffer to be done in or upon the property anything that may be or may grow to be a nuisance or annoyance to the owners or occupiers of any adjoining or neighbouring property.
- The Purchaser must not burn garden or household refuse or any other materials on the property.
- The Purchaser must not keep or allow to be kept in or upon the property any animals other than domestic pets.
- 11. The Purchaser must not undertake or allow to be undertaken upon or at the property any repairs or maintenance to any vehicle whatsoever.
- 12. The Purchaser must maintain the property in a neat and tidy condition at all times whether or not a dwelling-house is constructed on the property.
- 13. The Purchaser must not plant any tree shrub or hedge within the verge of the property shown on the Key Plan in such a way as to prevent the verge being used as a pedestrian walkway.
- The Purchaser must keep secure and in a tidy condition any refuse container or dustbin in or upon the property.
